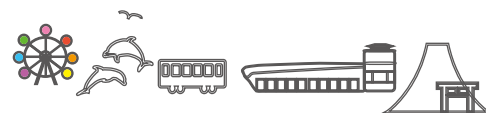

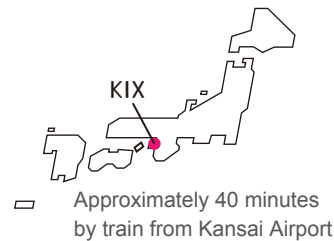

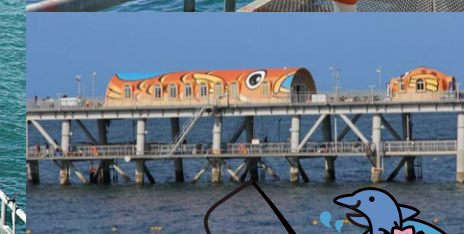


Koshima Misaki Ocean Fishing Park -Michi no Eki Totto Park Koshima

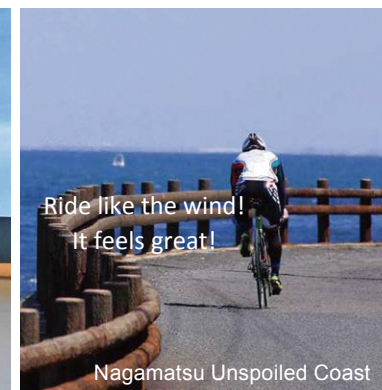

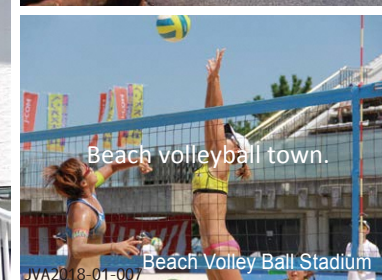

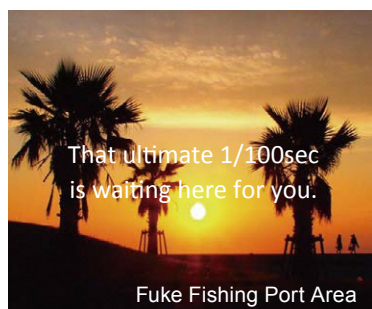

Minato Oasis

The Port Oasis is operated under a program by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Tourism Port Authority. It is intended to contribute to the revitalization of the local community through tourism promotion and community involvement centered on the port. Port Oasis Misaki is the first such registered facility in Osaka, and it covers Fuke Port, Tannowa Port, and the surrounding area. Future plans include further revitalizing the local area, expanding from Fukeko Tourist Information Center at Port Oasis Misaki.

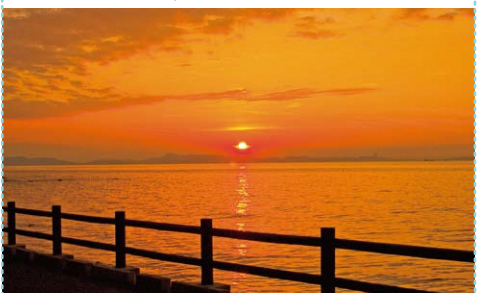

Udohaka Ancient Tomb

MAP I-2

Get to know "Goryo-san"

This 200m keyhole-shaped tumulus is surrounded by a water moat. It is said to be the tomb of Emperor Suinin's son, built in the 5th century, and is managed by the Imperial Household Agency. The moat reflects the beauty of the four seasons year-round.

Kosenji Temple

Kyoshi's Kannon in the Mountains

This temple is said to have been started by En no Gyoja (634-701) of Katsuragi Mountain Range 28 inns fame. The principal image at the temple is a 11-faced Kannon Bodhisattva is a hidden Buddha. Behind the main building is said to be the rave of Gyoja's mother.

Hojuji Temple

Looking out over the streets of Fuke

Known as the fossil temple, this temple has a Naumann's elephant fossil that was pulled up from the sea near Tomogashima Island, celadon ware from China, and a stone formed like a vase from Izumi. Visitors who wish to see the artifacts should phone in advance.

Konjoji Temple

They call it "Fuke Gobo"

Built in 1325, it is called the Gobo of Fuke. There is a giant ginkgo tree on the grounds that is over 500 years old and a registered natural monument. The temple was chosen as one of Osaka's one hundred great green spots.

Richiin Temple

Hideyoshi's beard? Why here?



This temple was built under the orders of Emperor Shomu in 733, and features a Gyoki Bodhisattva and the Fudo Myoo in the temple is said to have been carved by Kobo Daishi. Toyotomi Hideyoshi cut off his own beard and planted it. Stored at the temple are a statue of Hideyoshi.

Kozenji Temple

Famous Tendai Temple. Misaki Big Buddha



In 852, Emperor Montoku ordered Jikaku Daishi to make this temple. The main temple is a former national treasure and current important cultural property. The Dainichi Nyorai is said to be Misaki's Big Buddha, and it is flanked by shaka nyorai and yakushi nyorai statues.

Sairyo Ancient Tomb

As seen in "Nihon Shoki"

The largest keyhole-shaped tumulus in the Sennan area, measuring 210m at its longest point. According to the Nihon Shoki, Emperor Yuryaku ordered the tomb to be built for Kinooyumi no Sukune, who died of an illness while dispatched to Korea, in Tannowamura.

Misaki History Museum

Echoes of 1908

Misaki's history and culture can be learned here at this lifelong learning facility. It features a historical library, an archeology experience room, a Tanigawa tile display room, and a history classroom. It is a place to learn about local history, see Naumann's elephant fossils and onigawara (demon-shaped roof tiles).

Funamori Shrine

Five impressive "yagura" in October

The main shrine was built under the orders of Toyotomi Hideyori by Katagiri Katsumoto, built in the sangensha style characteristic of the latter half of the 1500s. It is a nationally designated important cultural property. There is a giant camphor tree on the grounds said to be 800 years old.

Fox Gods Telling Secrets

The only Shikinaisha shinto shrine in Misaki. The great torii gate has a plaque made of tile on it, hearkening to the days when the town had a vibrant roof tile industry. To the east of the torii gate is a monument to the time Emperor Shotoku visited the shrine.

Guardian Shrine of Kozenji Temple



See plants rarely seen in Osaka here. There is a Diospyros morrisiana, and a pair of guardian dog statues made of roof tile clay. On May 5, there is an annual festival where two large mikoshi portable shrines are carried around. The children who carry the mikoshi are rewarded with sweets. There is also a karaoke contest, so there's fun for all ages.
