



Udohaka Ancient Tomb

Get to know "Goryo-san"

This 200m keyhole-shaped tumulus is surrounded by a water moat. It is said to be the tomb of Emperor Suinin's son, built in the 5th century, and is managed by the Imperial Household Agency. The moat reflects the beauty of the four seasons year-round.

Koshima Sumiyoshi MAP A-4 Myojin Shrine

The autumn festival is also a celebrated feature of Koshima.

This shrine has long enshrined the four Sumiyoshi deities, protectors of maritime safety, and has been deeply respected for generations by the people of Koshima. The ancient ubame oak trees thriving within the shrine grounds are a rare example of sacred shrine woodland and have been designated as a Natural Monument by the prefecture.



Konjoji Temple

Built in 1325, it is called the Gobo of Fuke. There is a giant ginkgo tree on the grounds that is over 500 years old and a registered natural monument. The temple was chosen as one of Osaka's one hundred great green spots.

Sairyo Ancient Tomb

The largest keyhole-shaped tumulus in the Sennan area, measuring 210m at its longest point. According to the Nihon Shoki, Emperor Yuryaku ordered the tomb to be built for Kinooyumi no Sukune, who died of an illness while dispatched to Korea, in Tannowamura



Misaki History Museum

Echoes of 1908

Misaki's history and culture can be learned here at this lifelong learning facility. It features a historical library, an archeology experience room, a Tanigawa tile display room, and a history classroom. It is a place to learn about local history, see Naumannn's elephant fossils and onigawara (demon-shaped roof tiles).

Funamori Shrine

Five impressive "yagura" in October

The main shrine was built under the orders of Toyotomi Hideyori by Katagiri Katsumoto, built in the sangensha style characteristic of the latter half of the 1500s. It is a nationally designated important cultural property. There is a giant camphor tree on the grounds said to be 800 years old.

Fox Gods Telling Secrets

The only Shikinaisha shinto shrine in Misaki. The great torii gate has a plague made of tile on it, hearkening to the days when the town had a vibrant roof tile industry. To the east of the torii gate is a monument to the time Emperor Shotoku visited the shrine.




